It makes one wonder if the deer stay away too because of the constant barking. While listening to barking is of concern and an annoyance I'd rather not experience while on our own property, of a greater concern is to find out that he STILL has the dogs, however they are NOT barking. I had assumed the dogs were no longer there as I have not ever hear them bark over the past several months.

This situation is extremely concerning to find out he still has dogs and they are NOT barking. I certainly hope that an investigation takes place to ensure he is caring for these dogs in an adequate manner with feeding, shelter and shots, etc before any decision is made on giving him a breeder's license. Additionally I would expect the township to investigate past individuals he has sold dogs to on his website to ensure he is giving them adequate care and is following appropriate breeding recommendations.
